Due to the technical nature and complexity of the issues arising from the Council's decision to refuse planning permission, the Appellant requests that this appeal be decided by way of a Hearing. This is to assist the Inspector in their understanding of the principal matters. In accordance with Annexe K of the Planning Inspectorate's Procedural Guidance to Planning Appeals, we set our reasons below.

The unique personal circumstances of the Appellants, specifically their need for specialist housing for wheelchair users are at issue. The Inspector's assessment of this matter will be aided considerably by them having the benefit of hearing directly from the Appellants and ask questions of them.
The Inspector will also be aided by hearing evidence directly from HCUK who can assist in the understanding of the heritage aspects of the Refused Scheme. Again, the Inspector's assessment of this matter will be aided considerably by them having the benefit of hearing directly from HCUK and ask questions of their evidence.
