Comment: I wish to confirm my objection to Application A -22/0900/out and Application B -22/0902/FUL in relation to the redeployment of the Stag Brewery site, Mortlake.

Application A

I am very anxious that the the size and scale of this development will spoil our green riverside location and heritage. It is not suitable for this part of the river, and historical area.

Any buildings should be no higher than the Maltings. There are too many buildings-the density is overwhelming.

As far as transport is concerned the roads in the area are already gridlocked-from Putney to Richmond and beyond. And there are 3 more developments proposed locally. How will anyone move anywhere? I accept that there is a need for more accommodation. It it is the mix which is critical but not to the scale proposed.
