Comment: The proposals for this redevelopment are wrong on so many levels. The Mortlake, Barnes and East Sheen areas all suffer from severe congestion at at all levels, rail, road and public services are already at breaking point and broken. As a local resident of over 20 years we have witnessed continued in filling of any available space to the detriment of locals experiences. I cannot see how with so many objections the council can continue to ignore local residents views with such abandon. The site is restricted with access, the density is far to high, the height of buildings is out of keeping with others. This development will just turn this area into another river side development which will dominate the skyline and be totally out of keeping with the area. Water services are already at breaking point in the area and this will just add to pressures. SW trains are incapable of running their existing timetables with Mortlake station having been closed for weeks now, how are locals expected to travel to work?! Hammersmith bridge has been broken for years with no sign of a resolution. I cannot say anything positive about this proposed development and would suggest it just remains as a film set location permanently. With the Homebase development less than half a mile away proposing another 400 plus new flats and the Ham development more than 400 the borough has more than provided its allowance of new builds and this one in Mortlake is not needed or wanted by locals.
