Comment: This proposed development is totally unnecessary for many reasons the first of which is there being no need for a new school in the area as birth rates are know to be decreasing and by building this, would affect current secondary schools in the area. Secondly the plans would destroy much open green space which goes against lessons learnt during the pandemic and the need for open green spaces in any community for mental and physical wellbeing. lastly there is a crying need for a new school building for a school only a short walk from the brewery site, namely Thompson House. By building a considered primary school to house their students, it would not only take them to a safer environment, away from busy Sheen lane and Mortlake crossing but enable them to use the current playing fields rather than Mortlake Green.
