Comment: I remain opposed to the siting and location of a secondary school on this historic site.

There is no demonstrable need for another secondary school in Mortlake and East Sheen. The transport links are insufficient and will exacerbate congestion during the day. Since children will be either bussed in (thereby increasing traffic) or will be driven in by parents (again adding to congestion) or will cycle in (along dangerous congested traffic lanes crossing the A316 and the South Circular) the plan to put a school here is a nuisance to local residents and a danger to those children attending.

Regarding the sports area, this large area of playing fields is a local asset which will be denied to local residents as an attractive open space in an area of high housing density.

I urge the Development Control Sub-Committee to reject both this application and the associated one for development of the brewery site for housing.
