

Brick Piers:

AΣ ached document "brick front wall details" are our architect's drawings for the brick front wall with proposed 6 piers and further details included in the "HM_DRW2" document for where the driveway and pedestrian gate piers are located.

I've also included an image of the brick pier (it's obviously the wrong brick colour etc, but the configura@on of the bricks 'running' is the same, including a similar coping stone.



Thank you for your recent submission of the above applica@on, this case has been assigned to me for assessment.

I have reviewed the drawings and the design of the gates are acceptable but this DD relates to the VRC which sought for a brick wall. As part of condiθon U0142041, this sought brick colour, texture, bond, poinθng and detailing, a brick caping should be introduced to the wall and a detail provided of the brick piers with a coping introduced, along with detailed drawings of the driveway gates and pedestrian gates. However, the informaθon provided does not give this detail. No informaθon has been submiΣ ed to confirm what brick will be used, poinθng profile or bond. This is required to ensure the conservaθon area is conserved. As such, please provide these details via return email.
