Comments

Type of comment: Object to the proposal

Comment: The proposed development will further increase traffic on South Worple Way and exiting onto White Hart Lane. South Worple Way has become increasingly congested and dangerous for pedestrians, especially children going to local schools, with cars regularly pulling onto pavements to pass as at the exit onto White Hart Lane, it is not possible for a 2 way traffic flow. Additionally, cars waiting to turn right from White Hart Lane into South Worple Way regularly lead to cars behind getting backed up over the levelling crossing, often leading to other cars needing to reverse as the barrier comes down; also cars travelling up the wrong carriageway on White Hart Lane whilst the barrier is down to turn left into Worple Way whilst the barrier is down. With the proposed development there is an increased risk of this with a greater volume of cars and resulting safety to other users, particularly children given the presence of the nursery nearby and local schools. The added traffic will further impact on increasing pollution in the area.
