Three of our halls of residence are being refurbished and we think you'll love the finished results!

Seething Wells is having areas transformed into collaborative, social spaces and modern communal areas. The bedrooms and kitchens are being fully refurbished to increase your living space.

Over on our Kingston Hill campus, Chancellors Hall and Walkden Hall have had their bedrooms and kitchens enlarged and refurbished.

The redesign and refurbishment is being competed by <u>Equans</u>, a leading energy and services group. Renewable and energy-saving technologies such as air source heat pumps, solar panels, high efficiency gas boilers and LED lighting will be installed as part of the project.
