**Type of comment:** Make a general observation

**Comment:** I live near the corner next to the railroad crossing (South Worple Way / The Retreat). South Worple Way is not wide enough for 2 way traffic, so cars/delivery vans/lorries pull onto the narrow pavement, often at unsafe speeds - such that my small children are at risk of being hit by a car while they are on the pavement turning the corner! The noise level from horns and yelling is also very high.

The problem will only get worse if 100 housing units are added. Please can you explain how you intend to deal with the increase in traffic from already too high levels for this tiny street?
