I left a 'comment' on the planning portal last week, and am now writing to you in case you have not received it.

The letter from Gerald Eve which accompanies this 'outline' application refers to the site being 'bounded bythe river Thames....to the north'. May I point out that this is inaccurate. The site is not bounded by the River Thames to the north but by the Towpath. The River is to the north of the Towpath. This is crucially important. The Towpath forms part of the Thames Path/National Trail, and is a much-used pedestrian and cycle route, and its importance is being largely ignored by the scale and lack-of-character of this proposed development. The River itself is also being

ignored except in the context of being a 'preΣ y picture/preΣ y locaΘon'.... Why have we seen no menΘon of 'over-shadowing' for example?

I will be wriΘng further, but wanted to bring this to your aΣ enΘon now.
