Comment: I oppose this planning application on the following grounds:

- 1. The loss of habitat for native animals such as badgers and hedgehogs, as well as birds and bats, is inevitable. Sadly, such spaces are already in such short suppy as it is, and now another habitat area will be lost in this application goes ahead. The large chestnut trees will be badly affected by the excavations, and it is very doubful that they will survive. Can we afford to lose more trees in this area? Trees and habitat should be protected at all costs.
- 2. Vehicle congestion and parking issues in the three Closes have always been problematic. Now adding a further three units to tiny Roseleigh Close will add enormously to these parking and congestion issues.
- 3. The design and appearance of the proposed units are not in keeping with the existing maisonettes. The attraction of these three Closes is enhanced by the uniform visual aspect the maisonettes portray, as they sit neatly and unobtrusively together. The proposed new units are altogether different, in both architectural design and external building materials (for example, the green wall, solar panels, open terrace, and the inability to match the 1950's brick style & colour), and will be seen as an eyesore which destroys the character of the three Closes.
