### Comments

**Type of comment:** Object to the proposal

**Comment:** The Applicant gathered a supportive Petition in early August but has only submitted it two working days before the decision date: an abuse of the Consultation system. It contains some inaccuracies and a number of signatories will claim it was collected under duress. They were only shown an Artist's impression of the proposals and having subsequently seen the drawings submitted, wish to withdraw their signed support.

Whilst normal Objections are listed per dwelling address, the Petition has, in some instances, more than one signature at the same address - giving an unbalanced impression of the level of support. Three of the addresses have also submitted Supportive Comments - again over-emphasising their support. Two of the addresses in the Petition are not from 'neighbours' but from locations at the other end of the Borough.

I submit that the Petition has been "loaded", gives an unbalanced level of apparent support, should not have been submitted at such a late stage and should be disregarded.
