Comment: I am formally registering my concern that the proposed plan for the redevelopment of the Hampton Water Works does not adequately provide for sufficient car and van parking spaces. Neighbouring streets such as Belgrade Road, where we live, are already overcrowded with cars and vans both in the day and at night and it is often impossible to find a place to park in our road and in the surrounding area. There has been a major increase in traffic in the Hampton area since the pandemic and the survey that was done by the developers does not adequately reflect the present congested traffic parking situation. The erratic nature of public transport means that many people now use their cars because they cannot rely on trains and buses. There also appears to be an increase in the number of people parking in the area who come from outside the Hampton area and this is adding to problems with parking. I therefore urge the developers to do a fresh appraisal of the parking situation in Belgrade Road and other neighbouring roads with a view to significantly increasing the number of parking spaces for cars and vans in the proposed Waterworks development.
