Further to receipt of planning consent and in the process of the detail design it was found possible to improve the overall aesthetic and resolve some of the anomalies of the overall external envelope and awkwardness of the roofscape. See attached detail design drawing WD2 which shows the elevations as now proposed and drawing D6 which shows the design which received planning consent.
Please state why you wish to make this amendment
Aesthetically the original hip design introduces a shape that does not occur in the terrace where gables and ridges predominate. The amended design improves sustainability in terms of rationalising the build process and less use of materials as well as remedying the awkward facing (facing the main building rear wall) elevation where a steep half gable results with the original design.
