 To summarise – in terms of Conservation / Design; Window frames should match existing as close as possible and both elevational and cross section drawings provided to demonstrate. No objection to replacement with aluminium in heritage style which would have a similar appearance. Glazing should either be slimline, no thicker than 14-16mm, or vacuum, subject to further details on the impact on appearance and presence of silver coating. As the building is in a Conservation Area, trickle vents are not required, and their omission would allow for the most sympathetic replacement windows. Integrated trickle vents can be considered but thicker frames could have cumulative impact given amount of fenestration. No concern with proposed roof works which would not be visible from street and public realm.
