

Proposed Hedge specification:

Species: Taxus baccata

Height: 1.8 - 2.0m

Width: 60-70cm

Density: x2 plants per meter

Total plants: 24

Example picture hedging as supplied:



Maintenance:

Newly planted yews should be watered regularly for at least the first year, until their roots have spread out into the soil.

An irrigation system will be installed however the hedge will still require hand watering until established. Its important the hedge is not overwatered and that the root balls don't become waterlogged.

The Hedge should be trimmed once a year in summer.

Trimming the top will encourage growth at the sides so it is vital to do this to keep the plants bushy.

Every other year, mulching with composted bark fines will feed the hedges and keep them strong.

Case study:

Taxus baccata hedge, 1.8-2.0m upon planting, June 2023. Instant screen with no gaps between hedging



Taxus baccata hedge, 1.8-2.0m after 1 year, June 2024.

Hedge trimmed and filled out providing a neat consistent look.
