Details of the pre-application advice received
No in-principle objection to the proposed ground floor extension as there are examples of larger rear extensions in the surrounding area, most notably, at no. 67 which is also identified as a BTM. As such, it is not considered to adversely impact the original BTM or the surrounding conservation area.

- The use of contemporary materials is considered acceptable at ground floor level and would appear as an obvious addition to the largely traditional design of the original dwelling.

First floor rear extension

- The first-floor rear extension is objected to in principle as it would result in the overdevelopment of the site and destroy the original rear elevation of the BTM. This element must be removed from any formal submission.
- The introduction of the larger window to the left-hand side of the first floor is a welcomed addition as it reinstates symmetry at first floor level. Materials to match existing.

Ground floor side extension

- This is proposed to be moved further towards the line of the front façade of the original BTM which would not leave a sufficient and acceptable setback. The setback needs to be minimum 1m from the existing front elevation of the main dwelling.
- The large timber frame glazed infill panels of the front elevation are not acceptable as the contemporary materials do not match those of the existing host dwelling's traditional design. They create a cluttered front elevation.
- Please refer to the SPD for further design guidance on windows.

First floor side extension

- A double storey extension is already present to the rear with a flat roof and single window facing the street. No in-principle objection is raised to the addition of a first floor to the front section, provided that it is in line with the ground floor (note required set back) and is kept under the eaves of the main house as shown on the proposed elevation.

Rear and side dormers

- The proposed replacement rear and side dormers are too large and not of a traditional size, design and proportions as per the council's House Extensions and External Alterations SPD. The artist's impression appears to also show them set into the roof form. Therefore, an inprinciple objection is raised to this element of the proposals. Dormer windows should be no larger than existing and of a traditional design and materials. As such, this element of the design should be removed from any formal submission.
