Comment: As discussed in all the objections from Lebanon Park residents I am against this proposal on the grounds that it requires more parking when Lebanon park has already had to accommodate Ferry Lane residents and has insufficient space to accommodate more especially as the Riverside plans include additional parking. Ideally the garages should be knocked down to provide additional parking for the large number of residents in the Sion flats as they were initially meant to be and not substandard, ill thought out dwellings which require even additional parking and are not consistent with a 'conservation' area. Time and again we see -as in Ferry Lane and what has turned out to be a virtually total rebuild of this property with the entire summer made unbearable by the constant noise of building, that applicants as in this case and Ferry Lane resubmit and resubmit to the council until eventually plans go through with no consideration to the quality of life of existing residents and the character of the conservation area.

I request that this proposal is turned down.
