From our St Vincent Road WhatsApps group it appears most of the residents haven't received any correspondence about this.

There's already a considerable amount of traffic in St Vincent Road, in conjunction with the corner/bend in St Vincent Road would lead to increased danger for children. A turn around area would also have to be used creating more chaos, dust and danger. Emergency service vehicles would struggle to negotiate the area.

There appears to be a purpose built entrance gate at the end of Runnymede Road already. If an entrance at the end of St Vincent Road was built the children would have to then cross an internal road on school property as well. Another hazard.

Please request that the staff & parents/children use public transport to and from school to minimise the chaos during drop off & pick up times & enter the school grounds by the normal & abundantly huge front entrance (nearly 100 meters). Staff parking wouldn't be such an issue.

If the school is over capacity to safely maintain the front entrance I suggest capacity should be looked at.

This flies in the face of pupil safety and creates more dangerous situations.
