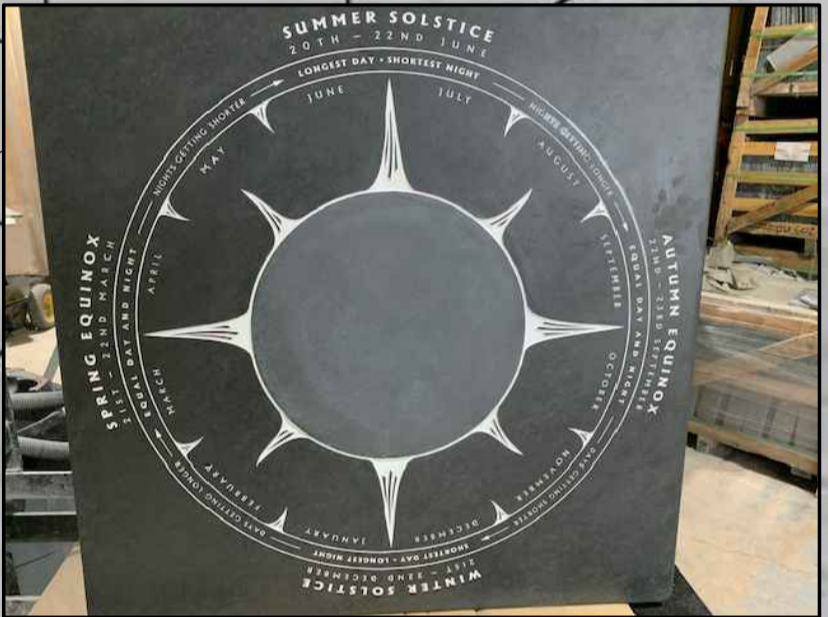

From 1976 the Boathouse was purchased by Pete Townsend of the Who and was used as a recording studio for many popular artists of the time including ..

- The Who - Quadraphenia, Who by Number and Endless Wire
- Thin Lizzy - The Yobs Christmas Album
- Pete Townsend - Who Came First, Empty Glass, All The Best Cowboys Have Chinese Eyes
- Motorhead - Another Perfect Day
- Damned - Phantasmagoria
- Souisie and The Banshees - Nocturne , Hyanea
- Strangeways - Strangeways
- Straight Eight - Shuffle and Cut
- Nilly Nichols - Under One Banner
- Marillion - Fugazi
- Medicine Head - Two Man Band

The Boathouse site origins

"A Boathouse was built before 1863 for the Royal Naval Female School which stood a short distance to the west of the site from 1805 until its demolition in the 1940s."

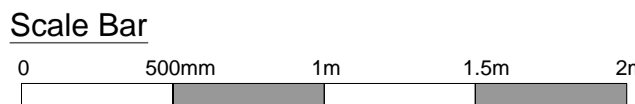
The establishment's Victorian Boathouse was replaced by the existing building in the 1960s by John Sims, having been previously known as Dick Waite's Boathouse.

In 1976 Pete Townsend of the Who purchased the site to convert to a recording studio with integral living quarters. The Boathouse ceased to operate as a recording studio decades ago and has since been in residential occupation.

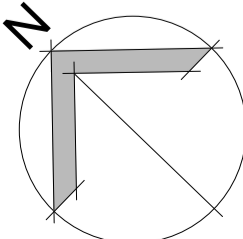
