**Proposal:** Variation of planning approval 19/2822/FUL - Variation of conditions 2 (approved drawings/documents), 19 (Green Roof and Solar Panels), 39 (Wildflower Green Roof), 40 (obscure glazing), 41 (balcony screen), of planning permission 19/2822/FUL dated 12 May 2023for Retention and refurbishment of the former police station building with part demolition of rear wings and ancillary buildings, and the construction of a three storey side and rear extension and basement to form a registered care home comprising 22 care suites and 66 care bed units, with shared facilities, car and cycle parking, landscaping and ancillary works (as amended by LPA Ref. 24/1512/NMA).

**Comment:** Reducing parking spaces at this huge planned care home is not sensible. Every space possible is required at the site where parking is already so difficult. Where will staff park? Where will visitors park? Reducing the parking spaces will just have another negative impact on those in the local vicinity. The roads locally are packed full of cars and are very narrow. You cannot park nearby. I regularly visit my parents on Queens Bench Cottages and have to park a fair distance away. Any sensible thinking person can tell that for a site with 88 beds, more than 21 parking spaces are required!

I assume that an ambulance bay will also be needed.

The building is already oversize for the site. It is absolutely shocking that the plans for a three storey building were given the go-ahead initially in a conservation area.

Councillors should visit on a match day to experience how parking is in the area.
