#### U0126026 Larger Scale Detail and Materials

'The alterations to the front facade shall not be carried out other than in accordance with larger scale drawings and samples of materials; which shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.


REASON: To ensure that the proposed development is in keeping with the existing building(s) and does not prejudice the appearance of the locality.'


## Condition U0126026 - Front Facade Details and Samples of Materials

#### Materials - Proposed doors and shutters

The proposal consists of three door panels, aligning with the property's three-bay character. Each door panel is vertically divided into two sections. The lower sections are solid panels with vertical proportions, matching the slender dimensions of the first-floor doors and windows. The upper sections are square toplights, further divided into four panes, reminiscent of the original design. Each door panel also features timber shutters that can open to reveal a fully glazed façade, allowing natural daylight to flood the interior. including the basement, whilst at the same time providing privacy when needed. All windows & doors to be painted a satin dark charcoal colour.







## Condition U0126026 - Front Facade Details and Samples of Materials

#### Materials - Brickwork


The proposal is to strip the paint from the facade in order expose the existing brickwork which will be repointed. The appearance should be the same as the existing rear and side facades.
