#### Comment:

- There have been numerous applications over the last twenty years for permission to allow vehicular access to this property which have all been turned down. Nothing would appear to have changed to overrule these decisions.
- This is a conservation area. Work on classic cars has the potential to be very noisy.
- Traffic comes round what is almost a blind corner into Johnsons Drive and access so near the end of the road is potentially dangerous.
- Ecology wise: The fig tree is too old to be moved; it is fruiting and need protecting.
- Parking is at a premium in Johnsons Drive, which is not the quiet cul-de-sac it looks like.
- To get proper access two/three spaces would need to go in Johnsons Drive to allow access to the property in order for line of sight to be safe, and make egress possible.
- Access would cause problems for parking and deliveries to houses opposite.
