Comment: I own an affected Garage to the rear of the Raised Planters @ 16 St Stephen's Gardens. I support the application by St George (via EKA) to responsibly cut the required tree roots in the Planter in order to enable the Raised Planters to be properly rebuilt in a manner which protects the foundations & new wall in addition to the adjacent garages at Dorchester Mews from water saturation / inappropriate drainage in close proximity which could cause future issues for the boundary wall and adjoining garages. Given the large scale of the works it feels sensible to ensure we get this fixed for a generation, not leave a known issue that could cause serious problems in a few years time at significant cost and inconvenience to both 16 St Stephen's Gardens and the garage owners in Dorchester Mews.
