Comment: Balancing the wellbeing of a mature tree, safety and stability of structures and aspirations of property owners is always a challenging task. However, safety and stability of large retaining walls that must last decades is indisputable. In this specific case, the retaining wall that runs across close to 30 properties must be completed in a way that water drains away from it, to ensure that it remains stable. The tree roots location could not be reasonably foreseen when original consent for the work was granted. I appreciate that the solution to the actual roots location involves compromising a planter / gardening endeavour of one property owner who feels that their design vision will be compromised. The solution proposed in this application enables completion of the wall that is 97-ish per cent complete, complies with all standards and regulations, and reflects the necessary compromises that need to be made to leave a safe and lasting retaining/ boundary wall for generations to come.
