**FRONT GARDEN**

**T1 Hazel (Corylus avellana)** Reduce laterally back from drive by 2m and crown lift over drive only. Final height = 7m and final spread = 4m.

**REAR GARDEN**

**T2-T3 Bay / Pittosporum** 20% Crown Reduction - Reducing the height and spread of the tree by approximately 1-2m to tidy and contain and retain furnishing growth. Final height = 6m and final spread = 5m.

**T4 Walnut (Juglans regis)** Remove regrowth ie reduce to previous reduction points ie by 1-2m. Final height = 8m and final spread = 4m.

**T5 Magnolia x soulangeana** Reduce selected branches to crown line by no more than 1m to be directed by client 4/5 branches in total. Final height = 9m and final spread = 4m.

**T6 Silver Birch (Betula pendula)** Reduce 3 x selected branches towards Yew. Final height = 3m and final spread = 3m.

**T7 Yew (Taxus baccata)** Lightly reduce to rebalance by up to 0.5m. Final height = 3m and final spread = 3m.

**NO TREE PRESERVATION ORDER** is to be made in this instance. The work may, therefore be undertaken subject to the condition(s) and informatives set out in the attached schedule but in any event a further notice to the Local Planning Authority will be required if the work specified is not completed within two years from the date of this permission.
