Than consulting us on the above discharge of conditions application. As condition 0146052 - NS11 River Piling- Method Statement was not requested by us, we have no further comments to add from a planning perspective, in line with our "External consultation checklist" (attached for reference). It appears that this condition was requested by Thames Water/ the PLA.

I have checked back through our response to 21/2758/FUL and identified the conditions on the decision notice that align with our requested conditions (also attached, for your reference).

The proposed works will need a flood risk activity permit. I have checked with the team responsible for issuing these permits and it doesn't appear that they have been approached by the applicant. So, I would strongly urge the applicant to apply for a permit for these works as soon as possible. If you could pass this onto the applicant, that would be greatly appreciated. The applicant should not assume that a permit will automatically be forthcoming once planning permission has been granted

### Flood Risk Activity Permit

The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 require a permit to be obtained for any activities which will take place:

- on or within 8 metres of a main river (16 metres if tidal)
- on or within 8 metres of a flood defence structure or culvert (16 metres if tidal)
- on or within 16 metres of a sea defence
- involving quarrying or excavation within 16 metres of any main river, flood defence (including a remote defence) or culvert
- in a floodplain more than 8 metres from the river bank, culvert or flood defence structure (16 metres if it's a tidal main river) and you don't already have planning permission.
