FIRE STRATEGY STATEMENT FOR 951 SHEEN ROAD, RICHMOND TW9 1YJ

- 1. The property is an end of terrace 2 storey family dwelling with accommodation in the roof space.
- 2. Built of 340/225mm thick solid brickwork, slate roof, suspended timber floors, timber doors and timber or upvc windows. The proposal is to enlarge a rear dormer.
- 3. The existing windows and doors have openings wide enough for Means of Escape being min. 0.33 sq.m. clear opening areas and no dimension less than 450mm wide x 450mm high [typ.450x750 clear opening]. Bottom of openable area not to be more than 1100mm above FFL.
- 4. The habitable rooms are all situated from the staircase and are not separated by fire doors.
- 5. The Means of Escape is via the single timber staircase.
- 6. All new external materials will be to requirement B4 of the current building regulations with Class B-s3, d2 or better, spread of flame.
- 7. Fire appliances can gain access to the building from the road at the front only.
- 8. The proposal does not affect the existing Means of Escape arrangements.
