Comment: Oldfield Road is a narrow, partially one way road that is used by residents and people cutting through to avoid the Hampton railway crossing. It is currently quite difficult to get down this road in a car due to it being very narrow and often access to drives are blocked by parked cars. If you come in the road at the Percy Road end, the council will issue fines (I have a driveway that I use throughout the day that backs onto Oldfield Road). The location of the proposed developments is at one of the narrowest points of Oldfield Road plus it is in the one-way portion of the road. There is no parking at this point apart from a few spaces and having a development in this location is going to cause more traffic congestion, blocking of the road for deliveries, a loss of parking spaces for residents and no doubt more instances of people's driveways being blocked.
