



- ① S1 RL1-4: Dismantle 1860s laylights set aside for interpretation use.
- ② Dismantle 1860s enrichments to ceilings, G9 F7 S1comica and doors for interpretation/educational use.
- ③ Dismantle 1950s window frames: G9 W1, G9 W2, F5 W1 to store.
- ④ Carefully lift encaustic tile floor laid in 1959 and set aside for reinterpretation in G3 pantry. Remove 1958 concrete slab to allow repair structural oak frame and facilitate installation of under floor heating.
- ⑤ S1 RL1-4: New oak quatrefoil laylights to match S3 W1 with new imitation Crown glass.



- ⑥ New terracotta hexagonal tiles to floor based upon documentary evidence.
- ⑦ New jib door to give access to architectural archaeology.

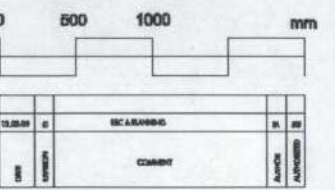
