Application to Remove this Yew

The tree is included in the TPO; it is a healthy tree in reasonable condition. It was suggested to the applicant that crown lifting and minor pruning of two small branches would improve the view of the Chapel from the refurbished piazza without requiring the removal of the tree. This was accepted, the Estate Manager even preferred to retain the tree as there is a desire to light it as a Christmas tree.

Recommendation:

- Refuse consent to Remove.
- ii. Consent to crown lift to 3m over the Piazza and trim two small branches over the new bench by up to 1m.

Sycamore T2

This tree is in reasonable health and condition although sparse foliage was noted. This could be due to de-icing salt or poor drainage and rooting.

The application was to "Prune back" at the site meeting this was discussed to establish a description of the pruning proposed.

The proposal is to Lift the crown to 4m above ground level, clear the new lamp column by approximately 1m and remove deadwood (minor deadwood was evident).

I recommend that consent for this work is granted.

T3 (T5 on Plan) various species included in Group 2 within the Tree Preservation Order.

This TPO of this group includes the following trees: two Yew trees; two Maple trees; two Cherry trees; two Holly trees; one Hawthorn; one Alder and five Weeping birch.

The works to this group is for two objectives:

- i. Improve sight lines on the South Eastern corner of this group so that drivers have a better view around the corner.
- ii. Improve views between the Chapel-in-the-woods and the main Chapel.

After a discussion on site the following specification was agreed:

Works to trees/shrubs not included in TPO.

Remove Elder and young self set Norway Maple in Southeast corner of this group. Remove shrubs including Eleagnus, Cypress shrubs, Mexican Orange Blossom etc.

Works to trees included in TPO (within South east part of group)

Irish Yew - No works

Two Holly trees – Lift crown to 2m above ground level.

Two Birch trees – Lift crown to 2m above ground level.

Common Yew adjacent Chapel - prune lateral branches to clear Chapel-in-thewoods by up to 1m.

Italian Alder adjacent Chapel-in-the-woods – Crown lift over pathways to 2.5m above ground level.

I recommend that consent is granted for the above works to TPO'd trees in this group.
