**Comment:** I strongly object to this proposal.

Twickenham Riverside is a rare piece of conservation waterfront that does not have urban development and is a quiet escape for locals and visitors and a play area for children. It needs tidying up and opening up to the community not overbearing private housing and yet another pub.

The scheme put forward is a massive eyesore that will block views and create disruption. The flow of traffic towards Richmond and from Kingston will be altered for the worse and there will be very little turning space for utility and emergency vehicles on the Embankment. Children's recreational areas will be sacrificed to private housing. It is not a proposal that respects Conservation or people.
