Proposal: Demolition of existing buildings and structures and redevelopment of the site comprising 45 residential units (Use Class C3), ground floor commercial/retail/cafe (Use Class E), public house (Sui Generis), boathouse locker storage, floating pontoon and floating ecosystems with associated landscaping, reprovision of Diamond Jubilee Gardens, alterations to highway layout and parking provision and other relevant works.

Type of comment: Object to the proposal

Comment: I object to this proposal on the following grounds:

1. The height of the proposed new buildings will cause loss of light and overshadowing in both Water Lane and Wharf Lane and the buildings will totally dominate Twickenham Riverside.
2. The visual impact of the buildings lacks style. The impression is one of low level, banal architecture, rather than high quality, stylish and original work suitable for a heritage site.
3. The layout and density of the buildings is inconsistent with the openness of Twickenham Riverside.
