Comment: I object to the planning application on the following grounds:

1. The wharf lane building is too high.
2. the removal of parking and vehicle access for the residents and businesses on Eel Pie Island is unreasonable and will undoubtedly discourage use of the existing local facilities.
3. the usual 'carrots' of new pub/ cafe and 'boathouse' take no account of the myriad pubs, cafes, and restaurants in Twickenham. We do not need any more.
