Comment: I do not think that these proposals will enhance the experience of the riverside for Twickenham residents or businesses. I believe the road management system is ill-advised, that the buildings are far too high and overbearing for this location, and that the primary motivation for this development is profit (private housing), not to serve the interests of the community.
