Proposal: Drop-in full application to supersede residential development zone of previously approved Outline planning permission 18/3642/OUT. Demolition of existing structures and redevelopment of site including construction of three new buildings comprising 106 residential units of mixed tenure (Use Class C3), alterations and conversion of two existing buildings for 3 residential use (Use Class C3), car and cycle parking, landscaping and associated works.

Comments

Type of comment: Object to the proposal

Comment: I wish to object to the proposal primarily due to the inadequacy of the roads around the neighborhood to support such a large development from both a parking and traffic perspective.

South Worple Way and the streets coming off of it are all tiny, quiet streets that already suffer from significant parking challenges and traffic bottlenecks. Adding 100+ flats will make traffic on these tiny streets worse and worsen bottlenecks around the rail crossing at the tight turn. Also, there is not enough parking in the proposal to support the units, so already limited parking spaces will be in increased demand. The proposal needs to have larger more direct access to Richmond road in order to work!

The medical facilities appear to have been dropped from this proposal too which is a significant disappointment.

The designs do not appear to be taking into account the quaint architecture of the neighborhood, nor are strict environmental considerations applied.
