Proposal: Drop-in full application to supersede residential development zone of previously approved Outline planning permission 18/3642/OUT. Demolition of existing structures and redevelopment of site including construction of three new buildings comprising 106 residential units of mixed tenure (Use Class C3), alterations and conversion of two existing buildings for 3 residential use (Use Class C3), car and cycle parking, landscaping and associated works.

Comments

Type of comment: Object to the proposal

Comment: I strongly object to this proposal, which will result in a significant increase in traffic in the narrow local streets that are already overcrowded, impacting air quality and the quality of life for existing and future residents.

The junction of South Worple Way and White Hart Lane next to the level crossing is already a serious bottleneck but will be the only access to the proposed development.

This part of SWW is effectively single track (cars can only pass by driving on the footpath). With large numbers of pedestrians also using this route, there is a clear risk of serious accidents.

Some cars (and delivery vans, etc,) will drive away from White Hart Lane, adding to congestion in the small streets between SWW and URRW.

This is exacerbated by the poor public transport service and closure of Hammersmith Bridge.
