Proposal: Drop-in full application to supersede residential development zone of previously approved Outline planning permission 18/3642/OUT. Demolition of existing structures and redevelopment of site including construction of three new buildings comprising 106 residential units of mixed tenure (Use Class C3), alterations and conversion of two existing buildings for 3 residential use (Use Class C3), car and cycle parking, landscaping and associated works.

Comments

Type of comment: Object to the proposal

Comment: The proposed density for this site is excessive. This will lead to many problems for all concerned including the residents who will live on the site.

There is insufficient parking on the site. Residents in the surrounding streets already have difficulty finding spaces. Most households own at least one car yet the plan is to provide only 50 spaces for more than 100 dwellings.

There is already a lot of traffic using South Worple Way, often at speed since the double yellow lines were introduced. In a narrow road with very narrow pavements this is frightening and dangerous for both pedestrians and cyclists. SWW is used as a pedestrian route to East Sheen and Barnes Primary schools. Often parents with pram and toddlers or school age children need to walk on the road.

The number of delivery lorries in the area has increased recently and is already causing problems. The addition of 100 plus homes will add to this in an area of narrow streets where there is already a lot of congestion.

I am also concerned about pollution, the environment and amenities for the whole community.
