Comment: Having just received consultation notification about introducing a "school street" at the Howgate/Vernon rd end of South Worple way, we want to point out that, since the one way was introduced at the end of White Hart Lane some years ago for the safety of the Westfields pupils, getting out onto Sheen Lane to cross the railway towards Mortlake, has being well nigh impossible in rush hour as it is!

Adding 106 new units on South Worple way would be is DOUBLING the occupants of South Worple way (currently numbers run to 107 which is the corner of Sheen Lane and SWW) even before 5 new houses are being built at our end shortly. see 19/3324/FUL.

These narrow streets cannot cope with any more demand on on street parking or extra traffic, nor all the delivery vehicles and construction vehicles that approving this development would generate.

We urge LBRUT to refuse this scheme, and attempt to fill their housing quota on streets that are safer.

As a disabled man myself I would have thought a care home or units suitable for the elderly that have lived all their lives in East Sheen would be more appropriate next to a SEN school.
