

I am writing with my views of the Mortlake Brewery site. I have been a local resident for over 30 years now. I think that the sports field should be kept as it is, so that local primary schools can carry on using it as they do now, and should be used as a local community centre for all ages.

If a large secondary school was to go there it would cause a lot more traffic to our roads (which we don't need) and also Mortlake station could not cope with the extra capacity of people. It would also be no good for the air pollution in this area.

I also think that the size of the flats should be kept to no more than 5 storeys high, we don't want a lot of

high rise flats in this area.

What is needed is more (much more) affordable housing for family's that live local now, and who's children have to move away from family + friends simply because they can't afford anywhere, also rented accomodation for them too.

So my points are:

1. No secondary school
2. More affordable housing
3. No high rise buildings.
4. No more added air pollution

I have lived in Mortlake for 55 yrs and I disagree with the plan for a secondary school to be built on the sports field which is now used for local schools to play their sports days and lots of outdoor activities and also football matches and training are played on there. Also Mortlake Station wouldn't be able to cope with the extra amount of people coming from outside the borough, the traffic on our roads is bad enough now it will be too much. We need more affordable housing than is proposed on the last count. These are my views.
